McNees Attorneys to Present, 'Healthcare Legislative and Regulatory Update' for ISCEBS

LANCASTER, Pa. – McNees Wallace & Nurick attorneys Eric Athey and Sarah Ivy presented "Healthcare Legislative and Regulatory Update" on Wednesday, May 3, 2017 at the offices of Trout, Ebersole and Groff, 1705 Oregon Pike in Lancaster. The presentation was offered by the Central Pennsylvania Chapter of the International Society of Certified Benefit Specialists (ISCEBS).

In this presentation, Athey and Ivy reviewed the rules and regulatory changes that are forthcoming and discussed the proposed changes.
