McNees' Andrew Rusniak Speaks at RKL Not-for-Profit Seminar



LANCASTER, Pa. – Attorney Andrew Rusniak of McNees Wallace & Nurick presented “Political and Lobbying Activities by Nonprofit Organizations,” on Tuesday, May 16 as part of the half-day RKL Not-for-Profit Seminar.

The seminar offered insights and education geared toward not-for-profit organizations.

Rusniak’s presentation focused on how Section 501(c)(3) organizations may engage in lobbying, and how too much lobbying activity risks loss of tax-exempt status. In a highly politicized world, what are the limitations on political and lobbying activities by nonprofit organizations? Attendees of this session learned to recognize the tax rules governing lobbying activities by 501(c)(3) organizations. Federal and Pennsylvania registration and disclosure rules were also be discussed.
