Hull was joined by Scott Barrett, the Vice President and General Counsel for Critical Process Systems in Burlington, Vt., and Eric Cotton, the Deputy General Counsel of DDR Corp. in Beachwood, Oh.

The presentation discussed using litigation as a teaching tool, and how best to do so in a way that imparts useful lessons while at the same time avoiding scapegoating. The panel also discussed how best to deal with customers, suppliers, and other third-parties in the aftermath of a lawsuit.
