CORSO TO DISCUSS THE "RISE OF THE DRONES" AT PURDUE UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF AERONAUTICS AND ASTRONAUTICS



Fort Myers, Florida — On Friday, November 8, Litigation Expert Michael Corso will discuss the "**Rise of the Drones**" to faculty and members of the Industrial Advisory Council (IAC) at the Purdue University School of Aeronautics and Astronautics (AAE).
