Gould, Chair of the firm's Environmental Law and Toxic Tort Group and member of the Oil and Gas and Food & Beverage Groups, and Bakare, who practices in McNees' Energy and Environmental Group, will review recent changes to federal

stormwater regulations affecting municipalities and other public bodies across the country.

Gould and Bakare will provide an overview of the recent Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Program changes and its impacts on state and local municipal stormwater permitting, planning, and financing.

"The regulation of stormwater and water quality is pervasive, and municipalities not only have regulatory hurdles to navigate, but in many cases must manage significant new infrastructure and costs," Gould said.

The presentation will include stormwater management solutions for meeting permitting requirements, the development of stormwater utilities, and rate structures.

The 81st annual IMLA conference begins Wednesday, September 28 and closes Sunday, October 2.
