The RPA Board Institutes a New “No Exam” Requirement to Secure an RPA Designation

Loss professionals can now exploit achieved acumen and earn a well-recognized mark of accreditation. The Society of Registered Professional Adjusters (RPA) has added an exemption to its membership applicant process that leads to the well-respected RPA designation. Long devoted to distinguishing claims management accomplishments, RPA will waive the traditional qualification examination, based on documentation that reflects twenty or more years of industry affiliation, or an equivalent professional designation.

Its Membership Credentials Committee, as part of its role, will evaluate applications and determine if the candidate meets the new requirements. The Society, for those who have not attained twenty years of service, awards its RPA designation based on service and the successful completion of a claims focused examination.
