Many of his cases have been reported and are among the significant cases in the transportation field.

He has taught Insurance Law as an Adjunct Professor at St. Thomas University School of Law and Florida International University College of Law and has taught a class on Transportation Law as an Adjunct Professor at the University of Miami School of Law. He is currently teaching as an Adjunct Professor at Florida Coastal School of Law as an Adjunct Professor in the Transportation and Logistics Program. Additionally, he has lectured on cargo and insurance issues to professionals in the industry as well as attorneys. Mr. Raab is also a Contributing Author to Goods In Transit, the author of Chapter 47 of Understanding Inland Marine Insurance Coverage and Chapter 5 of the Benedict Reference Book on Carriage of Goods.
