

## James W. Constable Selected as Chair of the Maryland Environment Trust, Board of Trustees



BALTIMORE, MD June 26, 2014 -- James W. Constable, a partner at Wright, Constable & Skeen, LLP, has been appointed to chair the Board of Trustees of the Maryland Environmental Trust.
