

Zarwin Baum Fashion Touchdown Raises \$130,000 for BBBS Independence

As the ladies debuted the 2016 Holiday Collection from Nicole Miller Philadelphia, the Eagles sported custom-made suits from Robbini Bespoke and shoes from ToBox.

Emceeing Fashion Touchdown for the third year were Alex Holley and Mike Jerrick of FOX29's Good Day Philadelphia. To kick off the show, singer Michelle Bonilla energized the crowd with a performance of "Just the Way You Are," the BBBS Independence theme song, and a few Big/Little pairs showed their charisma as they christened the runway before the Eagles hit the stage.
